A Klein bottle is a mathematical form in which inside and outside are ambiguous instead of being one continuous surface. The artist made a video recording of the bottle being made and projected it "inside" the form, a direct reference to Robert Morris's *Box with the Sound of Its Own Making* from 1961.
